Year 6 SAT's and Residential Information Meeting

As a year group we are heading towards our SAT's which are due to be held in May. In preparation for these we will be holding a parents information meeting on **Tuesday 14 January 2020 at 9am.** It is very important that a parent or a representative attends this meeting as we will be providing valuable information to help your child in the run up to these tests.

During the meeting we will discuss after school booster sessions, the time table for the week and the importance of support from both school and at home.
