

# Year 1 Autumn Term PLANTS

## DECIDUOUS AND EVERGREEN TREES

Deciduous trees lose their leaves in the autumn every year. Their leaves are generally board, flat and have veins running through them. Evergreen trees have green leaves all year round. Their leaves are generally thick, waxy and narrow like needles.

#### OTHER VOCABULARY

Branches -parts that grow out from the tree trunk and have leaves, flowers or fruit growing on them

**Bulb**—a root shaped like an onion that grows into a flower or plant

**Herb**- a plant whose leaves are used in cooking to add flavour to food or as a medicine

**Petal**—thin coloured or white parts which form part of the flower

Plant—a living thing that grows in the earth and has a stem, leaves and roots

**Roots**—the part of a plant that grows under the ground

**Seed**—the small, hard part of a plant on which a new plant grows

Stem— the thin, upright part of a plant on which the flowers and leaves grow
