#### <u> Phonics – Letter Names</u>

In Phonics, we are practising our Phase 2 and 3 sounds:

Phase 2 (s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g, o, c, k, ck, e, u, r, h, b, f, ff, l, ll, ss)

Phase 3 (j, v, w, x, y, z, zz, qu, ch, sh, th, ng, ai, ee, igh, oa, oo, ar, or, ur, ow, oi, ear, air, ure, er).

Ask an adult to hide letters around your house and go on an alphabet hunt.

Adult say: My sound is... but my name is... can you find me.

Example: My sound is 'a' but my name is 'A' can you find me.

#### <u> Maths - Length</u>

Make 5 different paper chains with your grownups/siblings. Can you put them in order of length? Can you explain how you have ordered your paper chains? Which one is longer? Which one is shorter?
