(BOYS sentences contain the conjunctions but, or, yet, so.) <i>'A comma must come before the conjunction!'</i> Explain that 'but' should be enclosed by 2 disputed sentences for example "I have warm cuddly fur, but my ears are as long as a snake."	English – Fiction Recap the story of Beegu Discuss/think about how Beegu was feeling about being in school 'She thought she found the perfect place'. Children will be writing a letter to Mrs McGunigall as Beegu, describing herself and why she would be a good student at our school! Try your best to use adjectives, similes and BOYS sentences.
