Dear Parents / Carers

Year 3 will be participating in a 'Stone Age Workshop' on Thursday 15 December 2022. Children will participate in a number of activities which will be provided by an external provider. During the session the children will learn about the following:

- **THE ICE AGE** and how it led to the Stone Age.
- **EXTINCTION** and the importance of Cave Paintings (the students will get to create their own).
- **CAVE PAINTINGS** – the students will get the chance to make their own cave drawings using crayons and leaning on walls / chairs
- **MAKE AN ARROWHEAD** – We use salt dough and spray paint to make stone-effect arrow heads
- **KEY POINTS** The creation of fire and how farming helped build communities.
- **GREASBY** – oldest known Mesolithic site in the UK (in the Northwest of England)
- **ARTEFACTS** – The students will have chance to handle a selection of objects that we bring with us (including arrowheads, spearheads, bowls, furs and an antler sickle)
- **HENGES** - the students will get the chance to create their own mini Stonehenge's using our fun kits.
- **THE BRONZE AGE** - how pottery came over from Europe.
- **THE IRON AGE** - How the creation of the wheel and superior tools led to new techniques.
- **THE BIG QUIZ** - To round off our days learning

The total cost of the workshops is £4.50 and payment should be made on ParentPay no later than Wednesday 14 December 2022.
