#### <u>Literacy – Reading Focus</u>

Listen to the story 'Jack and the Beanstalk' <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=-1GG5gYZ8c">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=-1GG5gYZ8c</a>

Discuss the structure of the story, what happens in the beginning, middle and end, who are the characters? Do you have a favourite part? Why? Can you role play the story with a family member?

There is a worksheet attached to the blog which contains some comprehension sentences. Please have a go at reading these sentences, or ask an adult to read them to you. After reading, can you draw a picture to match the sentence?

## Phonics - High Frequency Words

Practise the sounds – e, w, sh, th, ng, oa

Focus on learning the words 'you', 'all' and 'was'. These are tricky words that we can't sound out. Write the words on a paper and hide then around the room/garden. Ask an adult to shout out a word and you will try and find the correct word card.

Play a game on Phonics Play and choose a phase 2, 3 or 4 game. <a href="https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/">https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/</a>

Challenge – can you write a sentence using last week's spellings?

#### Maths - Patterns

What is the pattern? Can you make your own body movement repeating pattern?

Create your own repeating pattern using different colours. Start with 2 different colours and add more as you get more confident with the patterns.

Have a go at verbally answering the following questions:

- What did Father Peter give to David's mum and dad for him? (a candle)
- What promises did his mum and dad make? (To help David to grow up as a good child and a Christian).

Design and make your own Baptism candle using resources at home. You may wish to draw, paint or construct using materials.
