## <u>Literacy - Winnie and Wilbur Under the Sea</u>

We are continuing with the story 'Winnie and Wilbur Under the Sea'. Choose your favourite character from the story 'Winnie and Wilbur Under the Sea'. Draw a picture of this character and think of some words to describe the character you have drawn.

You may ask an adult to scribe these words for you or you can have a go at writing the words yourself, using your phonics to help you sound them out.

Challenge – Can you use these words in a sentence? Remember your capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

### Phonics - Consolidation

Listen to the song to practise the phase 4 tricky words Phase 4 Tricky Words Song Sight Words Song for said, have, like, come, some, what, when - YouTube

We are going to practise some trigraphs we have already learnt —'ure' and 'air'. Ask an adult to write some 'ure' and 'air' words on pieces of paper (chair, fair, pair, hair, hairbrush, airport, stairs, pure, cure, lure, picture, manure, secure). Can you read and sort the words into 'air' and 'ure' groups? Talk about the meaning of the words as these may be new words for the children.
