As part of our History and Geography curriculum, we have arranged a visit to Hoylake Lifeboat Station on Tuesday 17 March 2020. Hoylake Lifeboat Station was founded in 1803 and is one of the oldest stations in the UK. The station now houses both a Shannon class lifeboat 'RNLB Edmund Hawthorn Micklewood' and the inshore rescue hovercraft 'Hurley Spirit'. The children will have the chance to look around at the invaluable life saving equipment the RNLI volunteers use to keep our coast line safe.

The children will have their lunch in school, and we will be back by the end of the school day.
